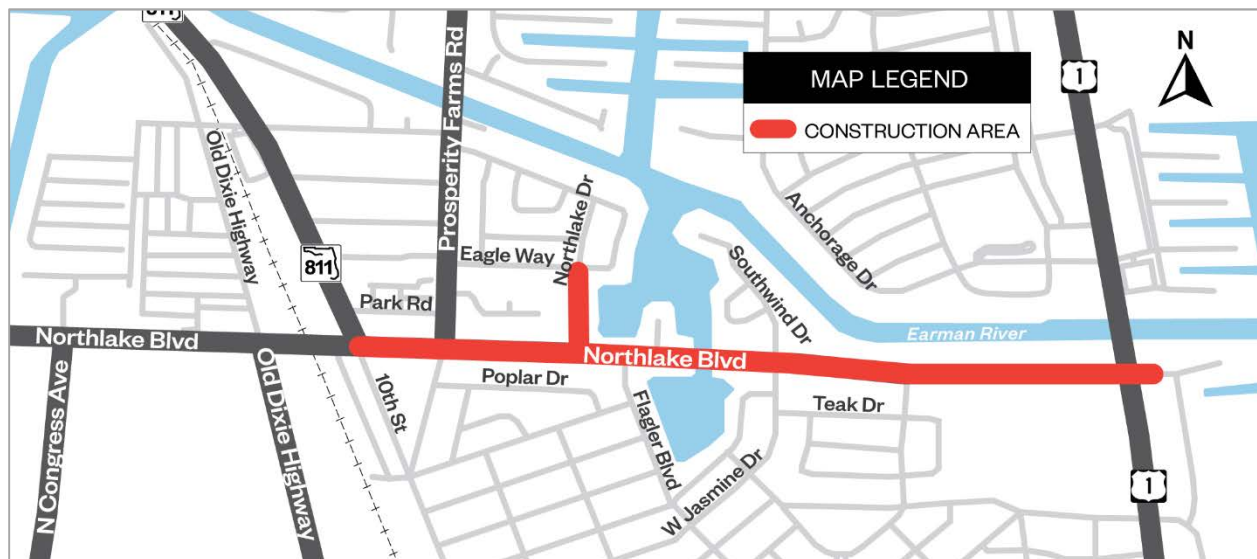
NORTHLAKE BOULEVARD WATER AND SEWER FORCE MAIN REPLACEMENT PROJECT

General Project Information

Seacoast Utility Authority will be upgrading the water and sewer infrastructure along both sides of Northlake Boulevard from Alternate A1A / 10th Street on the west to US-1 on the east. Work is scheduled to begin in October 2019 and will last approximately 14 months.

The existing infrastructure is nearing the end of its useful life. Consequently, this work is necessary to enhance the reliability and sustainability of this infrastructure.

The construction area is indicated in the map below. Roads will remain accessible but with reduced traffic capacity; expect periodic lane closures. Neighbors will be able to access business and properties during construction. Please follow posted detour signs and drive with caution in the area.



Temporary (short-duration) water and sewer service disruptions will be required during certain phases of construction. Our neighbors will be notified individually in advance of planned outages. We appreciate your patience.
